



Pedigree International Certified Savanna Herd Requirements

To qualify as a DNA certified herd with Pedigree International, the following items must be met.

1. All base stock of current registered goats must be DNA genotyped as a minimum. This includes percentage goats.
2. A copy of these case reports must be provided to Pedigree International so the pedigree certificates can be updated. DNA case numbers will not be printed on the certificate and do not convey with the sale of the goat unless freely provided by the seller.
3. Any offspring of your base stock that is registered, will be parentage qualified by DNA from the University of California at Davis goat DNA department. A copy of the DNA report will accompany the registration application.

Considerations:

1. DNA reports may change your current pedigree. Example: If a sire or dam is excluded by DNA report, the goat's sire or dam will revert to 0% until a new sire or dam is qualified. If a new sire or dam is unable to be discovered, this change to 0% is permanent.

(The above situation has already occurred)

2. DNA reports provided to Pedigree International become the property of Pedigree International. PI will not freely provide case numbers to other clients. However, there could be a situation that might warrant intervention by PI and the DNA case could be used.
